About the Speakers:

Joni Lynn Cassidy – Joni is Founder and Co-owner of Cassidy Cataloguing Services, Inc., a 22-year old company that provides contract cataloguing and other technical services to special libraries throughout the world. She has an M.L.S. from the Palmer School and is an Adjunct Professor at Queens College Graduate Library and Information Science School, and at Kean University in Union, NJ. Joni has been a frequent trainer and speaker for AALL and its local chapters, SLA, PLI, and Rutgers Professional Development Studies. She was a founding member of NYLLTS, starting with its planning meetings in Suki Scott's dining room. Joni will discuss points for evaluating products and vendors, the pitfalls to watch for, migrating to a web-based library application, and what the library should do to prepare for migration.

Lawrence Niculescu - Lawrence is Technical Services Librarian at Kaye Scholer, LLP where he has been since 1997. He has an MA in Romance Languages from Bucharest University, an MA in Linguistics from NYU and his MLIS from LIU. He was responsible for selecting and setting up the first ILS at Kaye Scholer in 1998 and he is currently setting up and transferring data to EOS. Prior to Kaye Scholer, he served as reference assistant, then cataloger and backup System Administrator at NYU Law School Library. Lawrence will focus on technical aspects of systems and conversions.

Bess Reynolds – Bess is Technical Services Manager at Debevoise & Plimpton LLP where she has been since 2005. She has an MS in Information & Library Science from Pratt Institute and an MBA in Finance from New York University. She was previously Technical Services Librarian at Cadwalader, Wickersham & Taft, LLP and McCutchen Doyle in San Francisco. Bess is the current chairman of the NYLLTS Roundtable. Most recently she implemented a migration from Horizon to EOS. Previously she has managed both another migration between systems (GLAS to Sydney Plus) as well as a retrospective conversion for three school libraries, from card catalog to ILS. Bess will moderate and discuss RFID tagging and electronic resources.
