Introduction:

Four vision groups will meet in the next month and will consist of all chairs assigned to a vision. This includes the chairs of both the primary and secondary committees. Respective executive board liaisons will also meet with each group. The MALL Executive Board will meet after recommendations are gathered from all the committee chairs regarding MALL's efficient leadership vision.

1. Committees with primary responsibility should review the vision document with their executive board liaisons and identify initiatives for implementation. For each initiative, the committee should:

- ❖ State desired impacts
- ❖ Assess costs and resources needed
- ❖ Establish a measure of success
- ❖ At completion of the initiative, success should be evaluated

2. For each initiative identified by a primary committee, members should:

- ❖ Prioritize
- ❖ Assign specific tasks to committee members (or secondary committees)
- ❖ Link strategies to *existing* responsibilities
- ❖ Report back to MALL executive board liaison

3. Committees with secondary responsibility should also review the vision document to determine if they can contribute to goals listed for the vision. These committees should also work at the direction of the primary committee to most successfully implement the vision, or to link work in progress to a goal listed for a vision.

4. At various intervals and at the end of the year, the Strategic Planning Implementation Committee should evaluate MALL's success in achieving its visions. Recommendations should be made for continuing working on the visions or for revising the vision and/or associated action steps.
