2001 marks **MichALL's 25th Anniversary.**

This year's meeting will provide an opportunity for us to reflect upon our association's beginning and development through the years, and also to look back upon some of our state's institutions.

The 2001 annual meeting will be held on Friday, May 4 at the historical Henry Ford Estate in Dearborn. The day will begin with a presentation by the Michigan Supreme Court Historical Society. Mr. Charles R. Rutherford will talk about the Society and its programs; Mr. Eugene D. Mossner will talk about *In re Huff*, a 1958 case dealing with the power of superintending control that the Supreme Court has over the lower courts and the judges of the state; and Justice Thomas E. Brennan will speak about the "Big Four", a group of four Justices who served in the 1800's and are credited with the organization of the Court as it is today.

MichALL past presidents have been invited as special guests to this celebration. During the afternoon session, they will have the opportunity to share their perspective on how the organization has served the law library community throughout the state over the past 25 years.

Our day will close with a tour of the estate. The grounds should be beautiful in May!
