Library Tours

The Mystic Krewe of SEAALL invites you to tour two academic law libraries located in Red Stick (AKA Baton Rouge). The tours are scheduled for Thursday, April 12 from 2 PM to 4:30 PM. A local librarian will accompany each tour.

The Southern University Law Center Library is located in the A. A. Lenoir Hall on the main campus of Southern University, one of the largest historically Black colleges and universities in the United States. The Baton Rouge campus is located on Scott's Bluff overlooking the Mississippi River in the northern section of the city. It houses one of the best civil rights collections in the southeastern region.

The Louisiana State University Law Center Library is one of the 20 largest academic law libraries in the United States. The Law Library is located in the Paul M. Hebert Law Center on the Louisiana State University campus in Baton Rouge. It is a selective depository for U. S. Government documents and Louisiana documents, and a depository for Louisiana Supreme Court and Courts of Appeal for briefs and records. The Law Library also has a world class collection in foreign, international and comparative law.
