Archival Boxes. One simple way to protect fragile or damaged books is to use archival boxes. The boxes are easy to construct.



Data Logger. A data logger should be used to monitor temperature and relative humidity. This is a newer model.



Temperature and Humidity. Devices to monitor temperature do not have to be newer models to be reliable.



Emergency Preservation. An unscheduled maintenance of the air conditioning system necessitated the fan as a quick fix to rising temperature.
