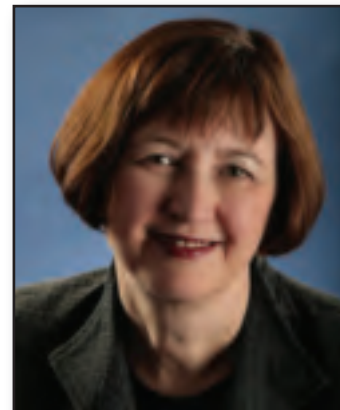
Ruth J. Hill, director of library services and associate professor of law at Southern University Law Library in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, was elected secretary to a three-year term.
