Article IV. Membership.
[Since the revisions are so extensive, a new Article IV is being substituted for the

Membership in this category is limited to five consecutive years.

(3) A person who has made extraordinary contributions to law librarianship or to the Association and who is not a member of the Association is eligible for honorary membership upon endorsement by the Executive Board.

Section 2. Rights of Members.

a. **Members—Active and Retired.** Any person who is interested in the objectives of the Association and works with legal information library services on an independent contract basis.

(2) **Retired:** Any person who is interested in the objectives of the Association, who has retired from Active Membership, and who does not qualify for Active Membership. [The person who has left library work for a vendor is "retired."]
