Goals and Objectives for the Year:

A representative to SLA supports the leadership and advocacy initiatives of the AALL 2005-2010 Strategic Directions and furthers AALL's interest in promoting the skills and abilities of AALL members by exposing SLA members to the writings of AALL members. The objectives of PLL are supported by exposing SLA members to the common goals, needs, and special interests of private law librarians.

- 1) Attend and participate as appropriate in the SLA annual conference in Seattle, WA, June 15-18, 2008. Report on the SLA conference to AALL and PLL.
- 2) Share the PLL Toolkit with SLA Legal Division.
- 3) Work with SLA's publications editor and/or local SLA chapters to republish AALL member-written articles in SLA chapters' newsletters.
- 4) Invite a national SLA person as a VIP to the 2008 meeting; work with PLL on hosting SLA person and networking with members. Ask AALL chapters to invite a local SLA chapter officer to chapter meetings.
- 5) Prepare other reports as appropriate/required.
