ALL-SIS serves as the umbrella organization for all facets of academic law librarianship: administration, collection development, consortia, directors, fees for service, interlibrary loan, public services, technical services and middle management.

ALL-SIS provides opportunities for all librarians to contribute to the overall betterment of the entire academic law library community.
