

## Directions to Loyola Law Library

Loyola University New Orleans College of Law Library is located at 526 Pine Street. The College of Law is located on the Broadway Campus of Loyola University, about four blocks from the main campus. The Law Library entrance is on the first floor of the College of Law building, at the St. Charles Avenue end of the building.

### Taxi:

The College of Law building is at 526 Pine Street, between the blocks of St. Charles Avenue and Dominican Street. Pine Street is one block off Broadway Street and runs parallel to it.

### From downtown by car:

Take St. Charles Avenue toward the uptown area. You pass the Loyola and Tulane campuses on your right and Audubon Park on your left. The next stop light is Broadway Street, but you cannot turn left there. Continue two blocks to Lowerline, make a u-turn, and drive back to Broadway. Turn right on Broadway, right again on Dominican Street, and right again on Pine Street. The College of Law is in the large white building on your left. You may park in the lot directly across the street, as well as in a small lot next to the College of Law.

### From downtown by St. Charles Avenue bus:

The St. Charles Avenue streetcar is not yet running all the way uptown, so you must take the St. Charles Avenue bus. Check with your concierge for the closest stop to your hotel. Otherwise you can catch the bus at Carondelet and Canal Street. Ask the driver to let you off at the stop closest to Pine Street. On Sundays, the bus runs approximately every 20 minutes until 6:00 p.m. when it begins running every 30 minutes. The bus schedule is listed online at [www.norta.com](http://www.norta.com).
