

# Locating E-Journals

Penn State Dickinson School of Law Library offers access to over 25,000 electronic journals

## To begin your search for a journal:

1. Go to <http://www.dsl.psu.edu/library/>
2. Click on *Online Catalog*
3. Click on *Access the CAT*
4. Click on *E-Resource List (A-Z)* (under Find Databases)
5. Then finally, click on *E-Journal*

You could browse the journal list by letter

You can search by entering the journal title or keywords from the journal title
